Dear SEIU FPSU Brothers and Sisters:

As the Elections Committee for FPSU we are pleased to mail you a copy of the Election Notice, Voters Pamphlet and the Election Ballot.

The SEIU FPSU Constitution and By-Laws provides that all eligible candidates who accept the nomination have the right to submit a qualifications statement and a platform statement. Therefore, any candidate who submitted a statement to the Election Committee within the prescribed timeline is included in this mailing. ***The inclusion of candidate statements in this mailing does not constitute an endorsement by the local or the Election Committee.***

In accordance with the FPSU constitution and bylaws, if only one candidate (s) is nominated for a given office (s), that candidate shall be declared elected without further procedures. In accordance with that rule, the following positions are declared elected:

Vice President for Operations – John McGibbon (Lake County Schools)  
Vice President for Political Strength – Theo Webster (City of Orlando)  
Central Region, Other – John Henkle (Orange County Library System)  
Central Region, School – Gene Phillips (Lake County Schools)  
Central Region, Municipal – Donald Graham (City of Orlando)  
East Region, Other – Nathaniel Evans (Palm Tran)  
East Region, Municipal – Josh McDermott (City of West Palm Beach)  
Member Strength, Lake County Schools – Sandy Gamble  
Member Strength, Palm Beach County Schools – (3 seats) Lovie Fulse, Vergia Virgil and Carry Walker  
Member Density, Jacksonville Head Start – Robin Kirkpatrick  
Member Density, Palm Tran – Paul Rich  
Member Density, City of Riviera Beach – Maurice Spence

All members will vote for President; five (5) Vice Presidents; and their regional representative executive board members; units with 500+ members will also vote on their member density representative and units with qualifying member density will elect their member density representative.

We have made every effort to ensure that this election process is fair and provides every member with a reasonable opportunity to vote. We established approximately 30 days for voting. Balloting will be by mail and the deadline for receipt of the ballot by mail only is **February 25, 2010**.
