

# Nomination Notice

## SEIU FPSU

Nominations are open for the offices of President, Vice-President for Operations, Vice-President for Finance, Vice-President for Organizing, Vice-President for Political Strength, and Vice-President for Member Strength; **ten (10) Regional Executive Board Member Representatives** (*three (3) Regional School Representatives, three (3) Regional Cities Representatives, and four (4) Other Regional Representatives of other units*); **five (5) Member Strength Representatives** for units with 500 or more members (*one (1) seat each for Lake County Schools and Pinellas County Schools and three (3) seats for Palm Beach County Schools*); and **four (4) Member Density Representatives** for units with 50 or more employees and union density of at least 45%, or for units with less than 50 employees and at least 50% union density (*one (1) seat each for Pinellas Suncoast Transit Authority, Jacksonville Head Start, Palm Tran and City of Rivera Beach.*)

The term of office for elected officials will be three years. All members of the Executive Board elected in conformity with SEIU FPSU's Constitution and Bylaws shall be considered as eligible delegates to any International Convention which may take place during their term of office.

Forms for nominations can be picked up at all FPSU union offices, retrieved from FPSU's website ([www.seiufpsu.org](http://www.seiufpsu.org)), or requested by emailing [elections@seiufpsu.org](mailto:elections@seiufpsu.org). Only FPSU members who have been members in good standing for at least six months immediately preceding January 9, 2010, may run for elected office. Members may nominate themselves or any other eligible member for office.

Each candidate is encouraged to prepare a statement of qualifications and a platform statement. Each of the two (2) statements shall be no longer than two hundred (200) words. These statements shall be included in a "Voters Pamphlet" which will be mailed with the election notice and ballots.

All nomination forms and Candidate Statements must be received by Liza Jacobs, Chairperson of the Election Committee at [elections@seiufpsu.org](mailto:elections@seiufpsu.org) or at FPSU's Orlando office no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 7, 2010, OR made in person on January 9, 2010, at the SEIU FPSU Founding Convention in Orlando.
